Dear Families,

Last week we had an excellent time celebrating Halloween. We hope that you all had a fun night and that you didn't eat too much candy. This week is a short week of school. There is no school on Friday due to Remembrance Day. On Thursday, there will be a Remembrance Day assembly during the morning class. Students in the afternoon class may attend as long as they are accompanied by their parents. The tone of the assembly will be very serious and solemn. Students are expected to be silent during the assembly and while entering and exiting the assembly. We will be discussing Remembrance Day and assembly expectations during the week. Please reinforce these concepts with your child at home. Students will be given a poppy to wear that day at school and formal uniform is required for both morning and afternoon classes.

For homework this week, the students will only practice the new graphemes 'e' and 'h'. For grapheme 'e', the sounds are the first sound in the word elephant and the first sound in the word ear. For grapheme 'h', the sound is the first sound in the word head. Due to the short week, the Grapheme Review will take place on Thursday. The graphemes for review this week are: e, h, a, qu and s.
